

Important Information Regarding Property Assessment


This may affect your 2020 property taxes.

The Open Book - Board of Appeal and *Equalization meeting for the **Rochester Township** will be held on **April 15, 2019** from **9:00 AM to 10:00 AM**, at the **Olmsted County Government Center**, conference room 1, located at 151 4th St. SE, Rochester, MN. The purpose of this meeting is to determine whether property in the jurisdiction has been properly valued and classified by the assessor.

If you believe the value or classification of your property is incorrect, please contact your assessor's office, at (507) 328-7396, to discuss your concerns. If you disagree with the valuation or classification after discussing it with your assessor, you may appear at the open book meeting. Generally, an appearance at the open book meeting is required before an appeal can be taken to the county board of appeal and equalization.

No complaint that another person is assessed too low will be acted upon until the person so assessed, or his agent, shall have been notified of such complaint.
